Eligibility Criteria:

- Full-time, degree-seeking undergraduate students enrolled in or accepted for admission to Ohio University.
- U.S. citizens or permanent residents.
- A cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 at Ohio University.

Selection Procedure and Criteria:

- The recipients will be selected by the Scholarship Committee in the Department of Modern Languages.
- Recipients will be chosen principally on the basis of academic performance or potential.
- Financial need will be a consideration, as determined by the O.U. Financial Aid Office. A FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is required. Check with the Financial Aid office for details.
- First preference will be given to a student(s) majoring in French.
- Recipients of the scholarship must be studying in France with preference given to students going on the O.U. program, Department of Modern languages.
