

Sue and Charles Glander Study Abroad Scholarship for Romance Languages

Eligibility Criteria:

- Full-time, degree-seeking undergraduate students enrolled in OHIO.
- U.S. citizens or permanent residents.
- Cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 at OHIO.
- Must be studying one of the Romance languages taught in the Department of Modern Languages: French, Italian, Portuguese, or Spanish
- Must have a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) on file with OHIO for the academic year of studying abroad.
- Must have submitted the online scholarship application through the Financial Aid Office. (<https://www.ohio.edu/financial-aid/types/scholarships>)

Application Process:

- Complete this application form.
- Write a one page, double spaced, essay in English answering the following question: "How will study abroad contribute to both your education at OHIO and your future plans?"
- Attach a copy of your most recent DARS.
- Submit all of the above to the Department of Modern Languages, 283 Gordy Hall no later than **APRIL 1, 2019**

Eligible recipients will be chosen on the basis of academic performance, application materials submitted, and financial need.
