Hotel Accommodations

We have 14 rooms reserved at the OU Inn (Room type: 2 Queens Size Beds)

Hampton Inn is within 10 minute driving distance from our campus.

There is a bus service from the nearby mall.

Parking on campus is not free and you need a permit prior to parking.

Rooms are reserved for May 17 to May 24 with all the flexibility needed.

Rates: \$109 plus tax per room (if you are willing/able to share, the rates are very reasonable).

Reservations need to be made 30 days before the conference or the rooms will be released to the general public. Cutoff date is April 17.

Rates: \$109 plus tax per room (if you are willing/able to share, the rates are very reasonable).

Other hotels:

Super 8 (740) 594-4900 did not give us block reservations. The rates are \$90/night.

Super 8 is also on East St. but further away from restaurants. Count 10-15 minutes to get to campus.

Meals

All hotels offer breakfast.

Baker Center (on campus) will open at 7:30 a.m. and offer choices for breakfast.

Lunch: Baker Center (on campus) offers a variety of lunches (sandwiches, salads, pizza, etc...) and is less than 5 minutes from Gordy Hall where the workshop will be held.

Dinner: many choices "uptown" with reasonable prices (national chains and local restaurants).

Also many choices close to the hotels but without local flavor.
