

# **Lecturer, Spanish: Online Curricular Designer (non-tenure track)**

The **Department of Modern Languages at Ohio University** seeks a colleague to develop and teach online courses in Spanish; lead others in developing online courses in French; and help incorporate appropriate technologies into the full spectrum of classroom-based teaching. The full-time position is for a Spanish instructor at the rank of lecturer, which is a non-tenure track teaching position. The ideal candidate will have experience in designing and teaching online language courses, be committed to working effectively with students, faculty and staff from diverse backgrounds and will have creative ideas for curricular development. Start date: **August 16, 2017**.

## **Responsibilities of the position include:**

- \* Work with Ohio University Instructional Designers and the coordinators of each language to develop online course curricula and materials for elementary and intermediate language programs.
- \* Prepare faculty to teach online courses.
- \* Work closely with language program coordinators and their faculty to promote the effective use of instructional technologies.
- \* Create and teach courses about Computer Assisted Language Learning (CALL courses).

**Preference** will be given to candidates with a PhD or equivalent degree; preferred a portfolio demonstrating excellence as a teacher and designer of online language courses; familiarity with educational technologies used in language teaching and learning; native or native-like fluency in English and Spanish; and the desire and ability to serve as a leader in curricular change. Additional qualities include: proven commitment to Computer Assisted Language Learning; working knowledge of French, German, Italian, Portuguese or Russian.

## **Minimum qualifications:**

- \* MA in Spanish, Applied Linguistics, or TESOL, or related field
- \* PhD or equivalent preferred
- \* Demonstrated experience in designing online language courses
- Demonstrated excellence in undergraduate online language teaching
